The CDC recently released **updated guidance for the use of influenza vaccines** for the 2011-12 season.

Highlights of the document include: vaccination of all persons aged >6 months continues to be recommended, information is now available regarding 2011-12 vaccine strains, the vaccination schedule for children 6 months - 8 years, and considerations regarding vaccination of persons with egg allergy.
