Dr. Allan Khoury is the chief medical officer of Take Care Health Systems, a component of Walgreens Health and Wellness division. Take Care Health Systems delivers care at 380 medical centers at the worksites of large companies, and at 350 convenient care clinics within Walgreens drug stores.

Dr. Khoury was formerly the chief medical officer of Whole Health Management, Inc. Prior to joining Whole Health Management, Khoury was the associate medical director for medical information at Kaiser Permanente of Ohio. He created the Division of Population Care Management, Prevention and Research to oversee disease management, prevention, health education and clinical research. He was also instrumental in the development of an electronic medical records system, which won the "Davies Award of Excellence" from the Computer Based Patient Record Institute. In addition, he led a Kaiser Permanente national team that created and deployed the Population Care Registry, an electronic tool to support chronic disease care, in four Kaiser Permanente regions with a total of 4 million members. Prior to entering the medical field, Khoury was assistant professor of molecular biology and viral oncology at The Wistar Institute in Pennsylvania.

Khoury attended the University of Miami, where he was awarded his medical degree. He also holds a doctorate in biophysics from Pennsylvania State University and was a postdoctoral fellow at Rockefeller University in New York. He received a Bachelor of Science in physics from The Cooper Union for the Advancement of Science and Art. Khoury is board certified in internal medicine.
