Richard L. Scott

Richard L. Scott is presently Chief Executive Officer of Richard L. Scott, Investments, LLC, which focuses on healthcare, technology and manufacturing investments. Mr. Scott is also presently Chairman of Solantic Corporation. Solantic is a leading provider of urgent care and health services in retail settings in Florida. Solantic opened its first location in Jacksonville, Florida in 2001. Solantic centers are staffed by board-certified physicians.

In 1987, Richard L. Scott founded Columbia Healthcare Corporation (later renamed HCA, Inc.) and began a decade-long effort to build an integrated health system to meet the needs of the healthcare consumer. When he left his role as Chairman and Chief Executive Officer in 1997, Columbia/HCA had become the world's largest healthcare company with more than 340 hospitals, 130 surgery centers, and 550 home health locations in thirty-eight states and three foreign countries. With annual revenues in excess of \$20 billion, the company employed more than 285,000 people making it the seventh largest U.S. employer and twelfth largest employer worldwide. Based on market capitalization, Columbia/HCA ranked in America's top 50 companies and top 100 companies worldwide. Columbia/HCA was also in the Top 50 of the Most Admired Companies in America, according to Fortune Magazine.

Mr. Scott was also the majority owner of America's Health Network, the first 24 hour cable network focused exclusively on healthcare (ultimately sold to Discovery Health), and is an investor in Pharmaca Integrative Pharmacies, Inc. (natural medicine pharmacies). Mr. Scott is a founder of Alijor.com (an internet connection between patients and healthcare providers), which was recently sold to HealthGrades, Inc.

Richard L. Scott was recognized by Time Magazine as one of America's 25 Most Influential People. In 1995, he was named CEO of the Year by Financial World Magazine and was also cited as one of the Top 25 Performers of 1995 by U.S. News and World Report Magazine. Mr. Scott is the past Vice Chairman of the Business Council and served on the national board of The United Way from 1997 to 2003.

A native of Kansas City, Missouri, Mr. Scott holds an undergraduate degree in Business Administration from the University of Missouri and a law degree from Southern Methodist University.
