Bruce R. Beavers, M.D. is an orthopedic surgeon in private practice in Dallas, Texas. He practices general orthopedic surgery, with an emphasis on arthroscopy.

Dr. Beavers graduated from Yale University *magna cum laude* with a bachelor's degree in engineering. He was a member of the Phi Beta Kappa Honor Society and the Tau Beta Pi Honor Society for engineering. He received his medical degree from The University of Texas Southwestern Medical School in Dallas, where he was a member of the Alpha Omega Alpha Honor Society. He completed his general surgery internship and residency in orthopedic surgery at New York University Medical Center, which included service in Bellevue Hospital Center, New York University Hospital and the Manhattan Veterans Administration Hospital.

Dr. Beavers grew up in Dallas and returned there in 1987 to start the private practice of orthopedic surgery. He has been working in the Dallas area since that time. He began a solo practice in orthopedic surgery in 2004. He was certified by the American Board of Orthopedic Surgery in 1989 and re-certified in 1998. Currently, he is a member of the attending staff at Presbyterian Hospital of Dallas and also at the Texas Institute for Surgery. He is a fellow of the American Academy of Orthopedic Surgeons. He is a member of the Texas Medical Association and the Dallas County Medical Society.
